Chief Minister reviews progress of NHIDCL road projects in Sikkim

Gangtok, January 13: A review meeting to discuss issues related to projects undertaken by the National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) in Sikkim was held under the chairmanship of the Chief Minister Mr Prem Singh Tamang at Mintokgang, today.

The meeting reviewed the status of NHIDCL projects across the State, including completed works, ongoing projects, and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) under preparation, while also taking up district-specific concerns for deliberation. Matters relating to Pakyong District were discussed, particularly issues raised by the District Collector regarding the section near the Welcome Gate, where two options; execution of work with uninterrupted traffic flow or execution after acquisition of additional land were examined.



Issues pertaining to Gyalshing District were reviewed with a focus on addressing administrative and implementation challenges affecting NHIDCL projects. The meeting reaffirmed the State Government's commitment to

strengthening road infrastructure while ensuring minimal inconvenience to the public through coordinated efforts.

New Delhi, January 10: Chief Minister Mr Prem Singh Tamang attended the pre-budget meeting chaired by the Union Finance Minister, Ms Nirmala Sitharaman, in the presence of the Union Minister of State for Finance, Mr Pankaj Chaudhary, along with Chief Ministers and Finance Ministers from various States.

During the deliberations, the Chief Minister presented Sikkim's perspective as a small border State with distinct geographical and strategic challenges. He highlighted the State's key development priorities and fiscal sensitivities, underlining the need for sustained support for capital investment, stability in devolution, and greater flexibility for smaller States.

The Chief Minister also raised important issues relating to connectivity, infrastructure resilience, employment-generating sectors, and the smooth transition of welfare programmes. Emphasis was laid on the strategic importance of strengthening border infrastructure, with particular focus on continued assistance for critical road networks and improved logistical connectivity.

The interaction was described as constructive and

forward-looking, with assurances that the concerns raised would be given due consideration.

Reaffirming Sikkim's commitment to inclusive growth and sustainable development, the Chief Minister reiterated the State's resolve to contribute meaningfully to the

national vision of Viksit Bharat 2047.

Bi-monthly inspection of major hydro power projects conducted in Soreng District

Soreng, January 12: A bi-monthly inspection of major hydro power projects under Soreng District was carried out by a district-level inspection team led by SDM (Hq) Mr Prem Kumar Subba, Soreng District. The inspection was undertaken to review the progress of ongoing works and to assess safety, environmental, and operational compliance at key hydro power project sites.

During the inspection, the team visited the NHPC Reshi Dam site, including the main power generation unit, and also the Right Bank Dam site area of DANS Energy Limited. The team reviewed the status of ongoing construction and maintenance works, adherence to safety protocols, fire preparedness measures, and

schemes and initiatives aimed at supporting farmers and urged the youth to actively participate in agriculture and allied sectors as a sustainable livelihood option.

On the occasion, farm inputs provided by the Agriculture and Horticulture Departments were distributed to beneficiaries by the Minister, reaffirming the Government's continued support to the farming community.

Photography training programme launched

Mumbai, January 9: A two-day project coordination meeting for the study titled 'Rapid Assessment of Fertility Trends, Determinants and Preparedness of the State Health System in Sikkim to Address Low Total Fertility Rate (TFR): A Mixed-Methods Study' was held on January 6-7, 2026 at Indian Council of Medical Research-National Institute for Research in Reproductive and Child Health (ICMR-NIRRCH), Mumbai.

The study is funded by ICMR-NIRRCH and being undertaken with technical engagement from ICMR-NIRRCH and International Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) in collaboration with the Government of Sikkim and partner institutions.

The study seeks to examine fertility trends and their determinants in Sikkim and assess preparedness of the State health system to address infertility and

related reproductive health needs. The findings are expected to support evidence-based policy formulation and programme design in the context of Sikkim's demographic transition.

The meeting was chaired by Dr Geetanjali Sachdeva Director, ICMR-NIRRCH. Dr Anushree Patil Scientist-F and Head, Clinical Research Division, ICMR-NIRRCH, and Principal Investigator, along with teams from ICMR-NIRRCH and IIHMR, participated in the deliberations.

The Government of Sikkim was represented by Ms Rohini Pradhan, Additional Secretary-cum-Programme Director, Sikkim INSPIRES, Planning and Development Department and Co-Principal Investigator, along with Dr. Suresh Madan Rasaily, Additional Medical Superintendent, STNM Hospital; Dr Nancy Lhasungpa, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, Nar Bahadur Bhandari

Government College, Gangtok, Ms Roshni Gurung, Assistant Director, Sikkim INSPIRES, Planning and Development Department and Ms Paden Sherpa, Project Research Scientist. Project technical support staff also participated through virtual mode.

During the meeting, Project Coordination Mechanisms, timelines and responsibilities were finalised. Study sites and data collection tools were agreed upon. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between ICMR-NIRRCH (Mumbai), IIHMR (Delhi), ICMR-RMRCNE, and the Government of Sikkim to formalise institutional collaboration.

The next phase of the project will involve commencement of field activities as per the approved timeline, implementation of monitoring arrangements and periodic technical reviews. Interim findings will be shared with stakeholders to inform policy and programme responses.
