- * Challenges faced in vaccination, ear tagging, and data uploading in the Bharatpashudhan portal.

All queries were duly addressed by the concerned officials of the polyclinic Dr Perna Gurung JD cum superintendent, Dr Ekta Pradhan DD, Dr Astuti Rai DD and Dr Karmakit Lepcha DD turuk nodal officer FMD.
