SICA Organises Summer Cricket Camp at Pakyong

Pakyong, June 28: The Sikkim Cricket Association (SICA) commenced the Summer Cricket Camp 2026 at Dikling Ground, Pakyong, on June 27th. The camp aims to provide cricket training to young players from different parts of Pakyong district during the summer vacation.

The camp began with an inaugural programme in the presence of Mr Sanju Pradhan, MEO, Pakyong Nagar Panchayat. Camp Coordinator Mr Karma Namgyal Bhutia welcomed the participants, coaches, support staff, parents and guests, and gave a brief outline of the camp and its training schedule.

Mr Sanju Pradhan interacted with the participants and spoke about the importance of regular attendance, punctuality and discipline during the camp. He added that the training programme would provide an opportunity for the participants to develop their cricket skills under the guidance of the coaching staff.

The camp will continue until July 5. Training sessions are being conducted by BCCI Level B certified coach Ms Kikam Bhutia, assisted by Level A coach Mr Karma Thilay Bhutia and Physiotherapist Mr Sharad Gurung.

The training programme includes batting, bowling, fielding, fitness and match practice. Participants will take part in daily practice sessions designed to develop technical skills, physical fitness and an understanding of the game.

Parents and members of the local community attended the opening programme.
