Team Sikkim participated in the “Regional Review Meeting for North East Region” organized by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India, held on 25th May 2026 at High Court Hall, New Capital Complex (MINECO), Aizawl, Mizoram.
