72nd Battalion SSB Strengthens Border Ties: Veterinary Camp and 'Vibrant Village' Economic Initiative Launched in Begha, Dentam

Gyalshing, March 6: In a powerful demonstration of service and community trust, the 72nd Battalion of the Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) organised a comprehensive Veterinary Health Camp in Begha Village (Dentam) on March 5. The initiative successfully provided medical treatment to 225 livestock, directly benefiting 28 pastoralist families in the border region.
