Women Legislators Participate in Capacity Building Programme ‘She is a Game Changer’

New Delhi, September 08 : MLA Gnathang–Machong and Advisor to the Women, Child, Senior Citizen and Divyangjan Welfare Department, Mrs Pamin Lepcha, participated in the two-day pan-India capacity-building programme for women legislators, “She is a Game Changer,” held on September 7 and 8 at Taj Surajkund Resort, Faridabad, Delhi NCR.

The programme brought together women legislators from across the country to deliberate on leadership, governance and women’s empowerment.

The programme, organised by the National Commission for Women (NCW), focused on strengthening the leadership and governance capabilities of women legislators and providing a platform for sharing experiences and perspectives on women’s participation in public life.

The programme addressed various aspects of legislative functioning, policymaking, effective communication, negotiation, decision-making and community leadership. The sessions also emphasised gender-responsive governance and inclusive development, highlighting the importance of incorporating women’s perspectives in policy formulation and implementation.

The first day of the programme was attended by the Speaker of the Lok Sabha, Mr Om Birla, as the Chief Guest.

The second day was attended by the Chief Minister of Haryana, Mr Nayab Singh Saini, as the Chief Guest.

Across the two days, six technical sessions were conducted, focusing on strengthening the role of women legislators in grassroots governance, community empowerment and effective implementation of welfare schemes and government policies.

The programme also provided an opportunity for women legislators from different States and regions to exchange experiences, discuss challenges and share approaches towards strengthening public service and inclusive governance.

The capacity-building programme provided a platform for women legislators to exchange experiences and perspectives on strengthening leadership, governance and community engagement.
