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Govt-e-Marketplace National Mission launched

Gangtok, September 13: The launch of Govt-e-Marketplace National Mission in Sikkim took place in the presence of the Chief Secretary, Mr. A.K. Shrivastava, at Chintan Bhawan, today.

The Chief Secretary, in his address, said that the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) is the National Public Procurement Portal which provides the facility of an online Marketplace for Central and State Government Ministries and Departments, Central and State Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous Institutions and local bodies, for procurement of commonly used goods and services. The main objective of the National Mission of GeM is to expedite its adoption and use by Central Government Ministries, State Govt departments and their agencies. He stated that the main aim for adoption of GeM is for an efficient, transparent system which aims to cut down on the time and expenditure involved in procurement of goods and services. It is a major transformational initiative to change the mechanism of procurement from lengthy documentary procedures as is hitherto being practiced in government to quick online transactions, he stated.

The Chief Secretary also enlightened that GeM will provide an opportunity for various categories of small entrepreneurs, enterprises and service providers

(such as MSEs, Start-ups, domestic manufacturing, women entrepreneurs, Self Help Groups) to come on board the GeM platform with their products and enter the level playing field shoulder to shoulder with the bigger entrepreneurs and enterprises.

The welcome address was given by Principal Secretary, Commerce and Industries Mr. Thomas Chandy wherein he said that the concept of GeM is in line with the Digital India initiative of the Government of India. The objective of GeM is to ensure that the procurement process is completely transparent, efficient and inclusive. Mr. Thomas Chandy stated that the Government-e-Marketplace was conceived one and half years ago and as per statistics available, the market place now has more than 27,000 buyers and 1,38,000 sellers having been registered on the portal and more than 4,77,000 products available to government departments ranging from vehicles and high-end electronic goods to ordinary stationary that one can procure through this facility.

The keynote address was presented by Director GeM Mr.

Sanjay Joseph who spoke on the Govt-e-Marketplace National Mission and said that it uses technology to make the system of procurement by government agencies contactless and cashless to bring greater accountability in public procurement across the country. A power point presentation was also made wherein the system was explained in detail.

It may be mentioned here that the National Mission for GeM was launched in New Delhi on September 05 at Hotel Ashok, New Delhi by the Minister of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, Mr. Suresh Prabhu. The two days State Mission will include training cum registration drive to be held at the Accounts and Administrative Training Institute (AATI) for potential "buyers" and "sellers".

The launch programme had the presence of the Mr. Thomas Chandy, Principal Secretary, Social Justice, Empowerment and Welfare Department, Mr. K. Sreenivasulu, Nodal Officer GeM, Mr. Dinesh Asrani, HODs, PSUs and officers from various Departments.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT:-

- Tender is open only to the eligible Contractors/Firms of appropriate Class/Area.
- The intending tenders/contractors should apply in writing for issue of tender documents. The application would invariably be signed by the contractor himself/herself. The tender document will not be issued to any person other than the INTENDING TENDER. The application shall be submitted initially for each work listed above with all required documents.
- The applicants should enclose attested copies of the validated/Updated Contractor Enlistment Certificate. It is mandatory to produce the Original validated/Updated Enlistment Certificate during sale/issue of the Tender Document for verification. Selected bidder should produce No objection certificate/ Tax clearance certificate from the commercial taxes Division, Finance Revenue and Expenditure Department prior to the issue of Work Order.
- The prescribed Non-Transferable Tender Documents (excluding the Tender, Form) can be obtained during the period specified in (As above from the respective Gram prasan Kendra, Cost of tender form shall be deposited to the revenue of respective GPU.
- Earnest money deposit @ 2.5% in State Bank of Sikkim shall be in the form of Deposit Receipt of Schedule Bank which includes deposits in the form of temporary deposit receipts(TDR) in favor of the Sr. Accounts Officer, Roads & Bridges .Department, Namchi. Tender form shall be issued from the respective Gram Prasan Kendra, only on production of the deposited receipts to that contractors/firm who has obtained the tender documents, on production of toward deposit receipts of 2.5% earnest money.
- The Tender Documents, including the Tender Form with quoted offer should be placed in a sealed cover with the name of the tenderers and the name of the work superscripted on it, Supporting documents listed at Sl. No.3 above should be enclosed with the offer.
- Sealed tenders may be deposited in the Tender box at respective Gram Prasan Kendra, on the date and within the time indicated above.
- Tenders will be opened by a Tender Opening Committee as prescribed by the Government in the presence of the tenderness on the date and time indicated above.
- The Tenderer should sign on every page of the tender documents as Acceptance of the general Direction and Conditions of the Contract and other laid down norms. The rate quoted should be both in figures and words and should be inclusive of GST and all other Taxes and Levies. Over writing and correction should be avoided and if made should be authenticated. Incomplete/Conditional tenders shall be rejected forthwith.
- In case of any discrepancy in rate(s) printed in the Schedule of Rates and Quantities issued with the tender documents, rates as per approved Schedule of Rates will be taken as correct. For items outside the SOR, the rates shall be as per the technically checked estimate/analysis. Decision of the Principal Chief Engineer cum Secretary/ Head of the Department will be final in this regard.
- The work value, scope and quantum of work are subject to change, the contractor shall execute the work as per the directives of the Department. No claim on this account shall be entertained whatsoever. If any claim is made, it shall be as per the agreement rates.
- Avoidable damages due to negligence of the contractor shall be at his own risk and cost. The Department shall not be liable for payment of such damages (if any), including accidents to labourer at site.
- The offer shall remain valid for a period of 90 days. The work should commence within 15 days from the issue of work order.
- All the conditions as mentioned in the NIT shall be deemed to a part of the agreement to be entered with the contractor. Security deposit shall be collected by deductions from the running bills of the contractor @ 5% of the value of work done.
- The Department reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tender without assigning any reason thereof.
- The recoveries of Royalties on Forest produces shall be as per rates notified by the government from time to time and applicable on the date of payment. In no case, claim of any contractor for deduction as per rates incorporated in Analysis of Rates or Schedule of Rates on the date of tender shall be acceptable.
- subletting of contract work is against the norm and if it comes to the notice, the original contract shall be cancelled and appropriate action shall be initiated as per the rules.
- In case the man powers employed by the contractors are from outside the State or neighbouring countries, it shall be the responsibility of the contractors to get them registered with the labour department, Government of Sikkim as per the relevant Labour Laws.
- The Department also reserves the right to increase, decrease, alter or modify the item of works as indicated in the NIT without assigning any reason thereof.

North District faces torrential rainfall

Mangan: The torrential rainfall in the North district has led to mudslides and landslides causing widespread damages.

To access these damages to life and property, the Minister for Forests, Environment and Wildlife Management Department, Mr. T. W. Lepcha and Deputy Speaker (SLA), Mr. Sonam Gyatso Lepcha, undertook a tour of the areas affected in and around Mangan with the District Collector (North), DFO North and other officials of the District on September 14.

A meeting to review the situation in the district was also held in the office of the District Collector (North), Mr. Karma R. Bonpo, wherein different line departments were allocated task in order to provide support and relief.

Further, on September 15, the MP (Rajya Sabha), Mr. Hishey Lachungpa along with Secretary for Land Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Mr. Tsegyal Tashi and other officials visited the affected areas and landslides in Mangan Dzongu and surrounding areas. The team assessed the damages caused and interacted with the people and assured all help from the State Government. Earlier, Mr. Tsegyal Tashi also conducted a meeting with the local people and Nagar Panchayats of Mangan. The Secretary informed that a Detailed Project Report for model demonstrative project for landslide mitigation of Rafong

Khola has been submitted to the Ministry of Home Affairs. The DPR, if sanctioned, will provide the much needed protection to the entire Mangan town. He said the focus of the project would be to map the flow of water and channelize it properly.

Mr. Tsegyal Tashi who is also the Member Secretary of the State Disaster Management Authority, said that the buildings and other structures constructed in Mangan should adhere to strict building codes, and zoning based on the reports of the Mines and Geology Department.

The team also visited Passingdang in Dzongu wherein several houses have been damaged by the mudslides which has caused much damage to dwelling houses, cardamom fields, livestock and horticulture crops.

The 112 Mountain Brigade of the Indian Army posted in North Sikkim and the Air-Force carried out helicopter services for the stranded tourists and local public.
